Precautions to take while using ATMs

- if you have opted to get receipt of your transaction from the ATM, please don't leave it behind. If you don't need the receipt, then tear it before throwing it away
- Look for any loose ATM parts/devices, which looks unusual it could be a device put by fraudsters on the ATM to steal information
- If you notice anybody behaving in a suspicious manner near ATM, please report it to concerned bank
- Subscribe for SMS alert and email alert service provided by your bank.
- Keep your phone number and email ID updated with your bank, this ensures that you get alerts
- Always check your bank account statement and report any unknown transaction to your bank
